<p>Income that we had anticipated or planned to raise this year has reduced due to Covid-19.</p>	
<p>We run services that support people from Armed Forces communities. Our services are open; and demand for our services is the same, or has increased.</p>	
<p>We have at least one year's published accounts.</p>	
<p>We have at least three Trustees or Directors that are not related to each other.</p>
