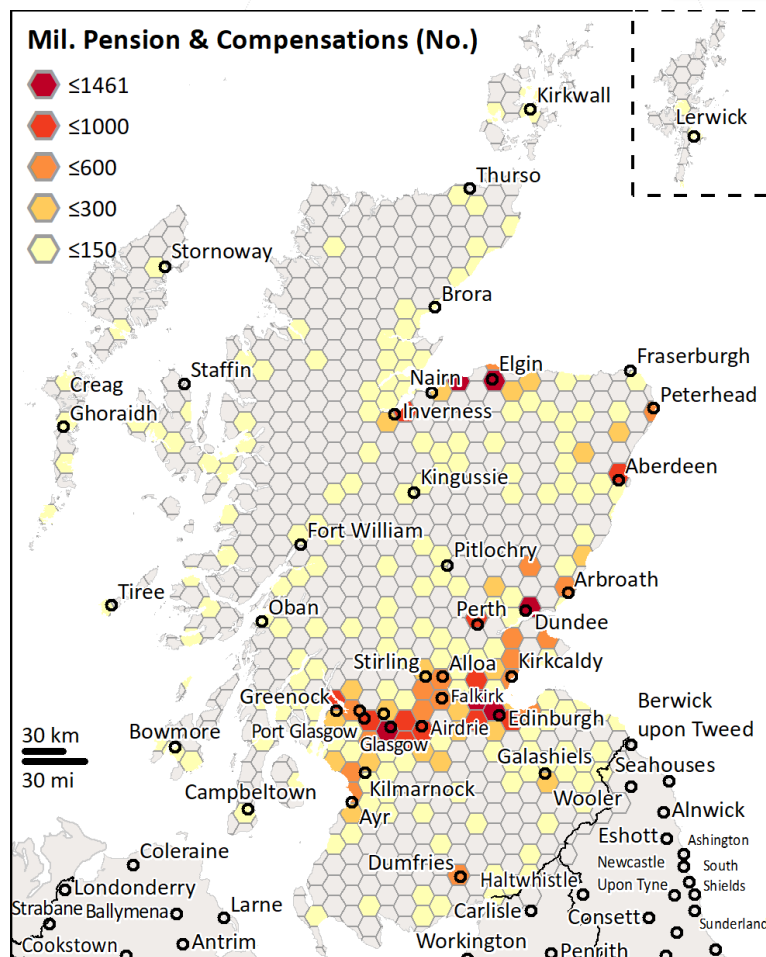

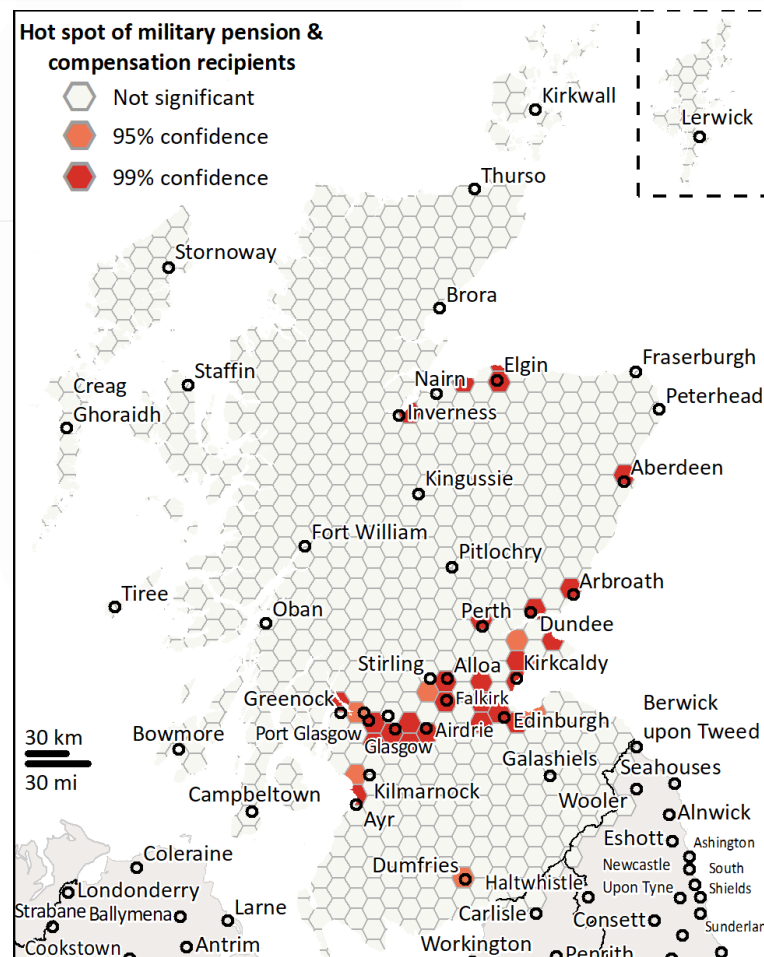

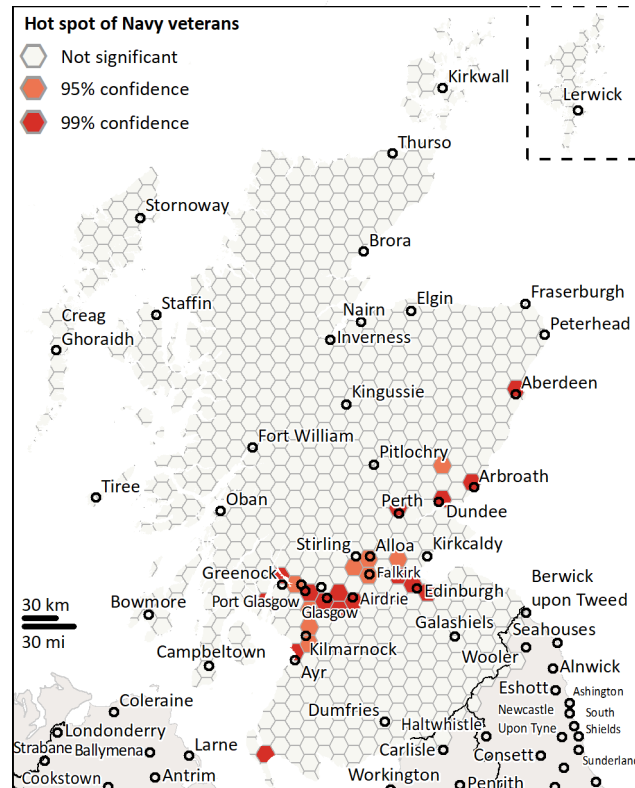
The figure above shows the distribution and count of military pensions & compensations in Scotland.

Hot spots of recipients of funding: Navy veterans.

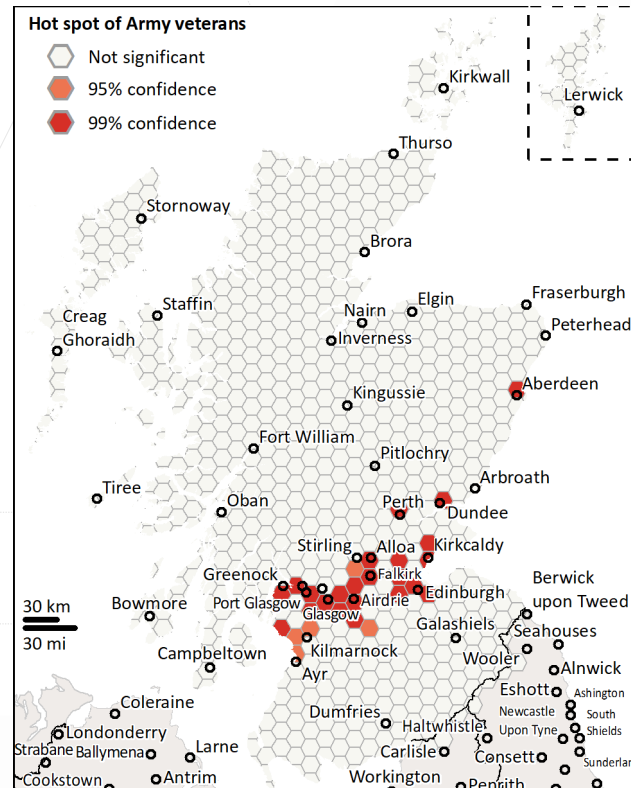

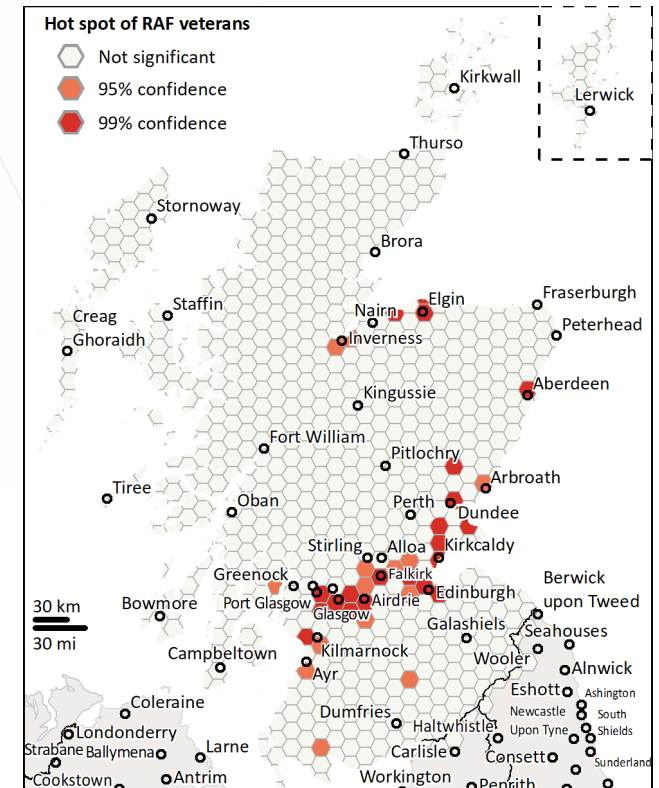
