All of the information that you need to make an application is in the programme guidance

But if you haven't made a grant funding application before, it can feel complicated

So, we've put this step by step guidance together to help you make your application

If you find that there are a lot of steps to get through, think about what it would be like to have the project that you are planning up and running.

Make sure you tell us in your application about the difference your project will make to people living on your unit Make sure that you read the full guidance document for the NAAFI Fund



Your idea needs to

- Help serving personnel living in single living accommodation or Armed Forces families living on or near your unit;
- cost between £5,000- £20,000
- Reduce isolation or boredom; or improve quality of life in a clear way





Your email needs to

- Give summary of your idea in 50 words or less
- State how much you'd like to apply for
- State which Armed Forces unit your project would take place in



If your idea broadly fits the aims of the Fund, then you will get a unique code that enables your application to proceed

As part of this you should

- 3 Application stage
- Set up an account on the grant making portal. There's information that can help you here (add link)
- Read the prgramme guidence carefully.
- We suggest that you download a copy of the word version of the application form (insert link) and work on a draft version

Your project needs to be able to go ahead if you get a grant

Get any permissions that you'll need

- Find out if your idea will need permission from DIO
- Who will be the inventory holder if your project purchases equipment or other items?
- Make sure that you've talked to everyone who you will need to deliver your project and that they will be part of it. What will happen if someone is posted elsewhere?

Check how your grant funds will be managed

Who would the funds be paid to if you get a grant?

- Talk to the finance/ accounts department at your unit
- You should find out who at your unit can hold the budget for your grant; and ensure they are happy with your plans
- We will need to know which bank account to pay any grant to; and who would be responsible for managing this money.





Get permission from your Commanding Officer

This shows us that there is senior support for the project

- The commander of your unit needs to give you a letter from your unit
- This letter should tell us that they support the project
- Your letter needs to be in an electronic format so that you can add it to your online application

Finish off your application

- Check you've answered all the questions
- Make sure that you have uploaded the letter of support from your Commanding Officer
- Make sure you add the unique code that NAAFI emailed to you







- You're done!
- You will get an email confirming that your application has been received
- You'll get a decision in March 2021
