### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### **Can we apply for a grant for a project of less than two years?**

You can apply for a maximum of £120,000 for a two-year project. If you are awarded a grant, you will need to take part in the programme evaluation over the full two-year period.

#### **Can we add additional duties to the role?**

Yes. We have listed core activities of the role in our programme guidance, but you could add additional items where this will benefit people from Armed Forces communities taking part in your project. We would expect you to engage with partners to ensure that there no duplication or clashes with other work.

#### **Can we deliver fewer activities within the role to run a smaller project?**

This is a targeted, strategic programme that will have a comprehensive evaluation. As such, all the activities that are listed within the guidance will need to be included in your project.

#### **We have a member of staff that is doing some of this role. Can we apply for funding for that post?**

You will need to ensure that all the activities which are listed in the guidance can be carried out as part of your project. You can expand an existing post. A strong application would address expansion of an existing role in a proportionate way; and avoid duplication of funding.

#### **Can the post be filled by a secondee?**

Yes, the role could be delivered by a secondee.
