

Applying to the Armed Forces Families Fund Early Years programme

Do you have at least 50% Service children on roll?



Yes




You can make a single application



Applications from single settings must meet one of three outcomes



 Increased capacity at the setting to allow more Service children to attend



Better learning environments for Service children



Have provided appropriate training and development of staff to support Service children



You'll need to show us that you have consulted with Service families to ensure your project is meeting their needs



You can apply for £5K to £50K, for a project lasting up to two years



DIO should not need to be involved in your project at all - either for permissions or undertaking work

You can apply as part of a cluster of settings



Clusters of settings, each with less than 50% of Service children on roll, can apply for



Staff training with an Armed Forces focus



funding for a shared resource, for example a roving Armed Forces Early Years Support Worker



You'll need to show us that your project will **mainly benefit Service children**



One setting, or the local authority will need to act as the lead applicant for your cluster
